### **The Older Adult**

This is described further in Chapter 4. Vomiting blood or a chief complaint of blood per rectum should be seriously considered and evaluated in the context of vital signs. A 30-year-old with bright red blood per rectum, normal vital signs is appropriately an emergency but does not warrant an ESI level-2 designation.
