In 1999, section 124 of the Balanced Budget Refinement Act or BBRA required that a per diem (daily) PPS be developed for payment to be made for inpatient psychiatric services furnished in psychiatric hospitals and psychiatric units of acute care hospitals and critical access hospitals. Section 124 of the BBRA required the IPF PPS be implemented for cost reporting periods beginning on or after October 1, 2002.

Psychiatric hospitals participating in Medicare and accredited by AoA or JCAHO under their hospital accreditation programs or under JCAHO's consolidated standards for adult psychiatric facilities are deemed to meet the Medicare requirements for hospitals, with the exception of the special medical record and staffing requirements.

The per diem prospective payment system was implemented for inpatient psychiatric services that are furnished in a psychiatric hospital, units in an acute care hospitals or a critical access hospital. Under this system, payment to IPFs is based on a Federal per diem base rate that includes both inpatient operating and capital-related costs (including routine and ancillary services) but excludes certain pass-through costs (i.e., bad debt and direct medical education).

To meet the IPFQR program requirements, inpatient psychiatric facilities (IPFs), which include psychiatric hospitals and psychiatric units, are required to submit to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) data on quality measures specified by CMS.
